

NWNNA General Meeting January 25th 2018

Meeting was called to order by President, Al Pierson at 6:36 pm

Minutes of October meeting were passed over due to the absence of the Secretary and notes therefor no minutes were approved.

Financial Report per Teresa Dusil, Funds total \$16,500 (Actual \$16591.45) and approx. \$3000 to \$2800 coming in from the city re-imbusement. These funds cover expenses for payroll and the daily operation of the NW neighborhood community resource center.

Police Report: Lt. McGarvey was absent and no report was given. Another officer will be assigned to present reports soon.

City Staff Reports were presented:

Steve Hirschner- O Ave. Construction open house Feb. 1st at Roosevelt MS. Flood protection control plan hand outs coming. April leaf pick up. Water main break on O Ave. Addressed.
Angie Cole- Parks & Rec. Event for the holidays was very successful. Over 700 people attended. 3 on 3 basketball is the biggest program at the center. Over 150 games are scheduled to be played.

Annette, Save CR- 183 active nuisance properties city wide, only 25 in the NW quadrant. Nuisance properties were discussed. Green space violators/vandals discussed.

Nina- City code enforcement- Demo of 2 properties discussed. 1124 6th St. and 1338 6th St. NW

Old Business: Al wrote a guest editorial in the Gazette about the history of the NW neighborhood and the Time Check history. Al presented the current funds raised to date. \$245,000. Also discussed was placement of the monument and the O Ave. revitalization and placement of the road itself. Rockin' Reunion name changed to Rockin' Ellis Park. Mailings going out to neighborhood on meetings and speakers. Pastor Carol retiring and a replacement will be needed on the board. Shakespeare garden revitalization. Sylvia spoke on this and the Garden Clubs role in this project.

Re-Zone CR Speakers: Anne Russett and Seth Gunnerson, a PowerPoint presentation and handouts of the mapping of the new zoning and suggested areas of development.
